Art

The Mandorla Art Award is an award for contemporary religious art in Australia and has been held since 1985. New Norcia is hosting the award for three weeks and the presentation of the people's choice award (sponsored by the Benedictine Monks of New Norcia) is being held in New Norcia on Saturday 20 November.

In addition, respected Perth artist and art teacher, Leonie Dobrowolski, is bringing a group of art students to New Norcia for the weekend to complete their latest work. The students will be set up in St Gertrude's wooden hall and there will be plenty of opportunity for people to view their work and then in the afternoon session to speak to the artists about their paintings.



MUSIC



The Winthrop Singers will be performing a concert on Sunday 21st in the Abbey Church. The Winthrop Singers were formed in February 2007 in a partnership between the School of Music and St George's College at the University of Western Australia in Perth. Their programme on the Sunday will include works by Tomás Luis de Victoria, Francisco Guerrero and Dom Stephen Moreno, a Spanish monk of New Norcia who was a prolific composer during the first half of the 20th century. They will also be performing Christmas music from a variety of cultures in the Mediterranean that celebrate the role of the shepherds in the Nativity story. They will be accompanied by Gabrielle Mercer, the organist and liturgy coordinator in New Norcia, who will perform organ solos by Antonio de Cabezón.

Food

Following the concert, a lunch will be held on Sunday 21st in the Arcades behind St Ildephonsus'. It will be a simple lunch of authentic Spanish cuisine. You will enjoy plates of tapas with New Norcia bread and our award winning olive oil before moving onto that most traditional of Spanish dishes, Paella, cooked before you in the Arcades and served straight from the pan with Mediterranean salads. Dessert will see you savouring Tarta de Santiago (a sweet cake from the region of Spain that Abbot Salvado hailed from) and fruit. And all this will be served with a selection of New Norcia Abbey Wines.
